Dear Second Grade Families:

As you know, homework is often a necessary extension to the learning that takes place at school. Usually, it is given so that the students may independently try to complete exercises for concepts that were taught in the classroom. Homework can be a very good indicator of trouble spots in your child's learning because lessons are taught whole group while independent practice reveals whether or not your child understood the concepts that were taught.

Having stated the above, homework should not be considered optional. If there is some reason your child cannot complete a given assignment, a note of explanation would be very helpful. Should homework not be turned in to the teacher and no note is sent, the student's Behavior/Work Habits Chart will indicate the missed homework. The student's workbook page or worksheet will get marked with "HW" and it then becomes the responsibility of the student and parent to see that the assignment gets done. Any consistent missing of homework assignments can and will affect your child's learning. Please encourage good work habits in the home.

Parents are asked to check your child's homework for the following:

1. Completion
2. Accuracy
3. Neatness
